CHRISTMAS BREAK

SICKNESS

Students or staff who complain of not feeling well, will have their temperature taken and sent home if they have a fever of 100.4°F or above and/or respiratory infection symptoms. With the rising number of cases in the area if your child is nauseous, tired, achy, sore throat, please keep them home. We are also asking all dancers to wear masks, even during class.

Parents need to update their emergency contact information to ensure dancers can be picked up immediately. Please follow standard guidelines when your child is sick and use common sense before returning to the studio. Your Dancer must be Fever free for 24 hours without any medication!

We are updating Band and will be posting on the App. We can also Zoom your child in class if they are sick or quarantined. Please let us know if you wish to Zoom. Again, this is for the safety of our dancers and staff.

TUITION
