PLEASE NOTE: TUITION POLICY

ANY DANCER’S TUITION THAT IS MORE THAN ONE MONTH PAST DUE WILL BE ALLOWED TO ATTEND CLASSES, BUT WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO PARTICIPATE. If your accounts are past due, we will be reaching out to you to set up a payment plan.

LOBBY

We strive to keep our lobby healthy, clean, comfortable and as peaceful as possible for all. To maintain this during this busy season, we kindly ask that our lobby be used for quick drop-off and pick-up only. To limit exposure during your dancers’ class time please avoid extended waiting in the lobby. Dancers should arrive only 5 minutes before class. Also, a friendly reminder, benches are for dancers only. We need to keep the hallway clear for classes coming in and going out.

BREAK ROOM

If your dancer has a break, they are welcome to stay in our breakroom as long as they remain respectful and keep the noise level to a minimum. Many dancers use the breakroom to eat or do homework. Dancers will be given 1 warning if the rules are not followed. After the first warning, they will no longer be able to stay on their breaks. Any dancers 1st grade and under should not be left longer than 30 minutes.

BAND APP

Please make sure you have signed up for the BAND app, we will be posting the videos of classes, so our dancers can practice at home.
